Eligibility Criteria/Requirement:

The applicants must meet the following minimum criteria;

- Must be a Kenyan citizen aged between 18-35 years old.
- Must meet the minimum course requirements-Kenya Certificate of Primary Education(KCPE)
- Must demonstrate the need for financial assistance by providing supporting documents such as an introductory letter from the Area Chief.

Duration and commencement:

The Scholarship will last for one (1) year beginning May, 2022. The Scholarship must be taken at the time of offer (no deferments and temporary withdrawal from studies while on scholarship).

Equal opportunities:

Candidates from less privileged regions, areas suffering from poverty, orphaned youth and persons with disabilities (PWDs) are encouraged to apply.

Applicants are expected to write an application letter addressed to The Principal and attach the following;
